

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

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Measure Description:

Requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services to contract with private entity to evaluate progress of coordinated care organizations in achieving goals of Legislative Assembly.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting House Bill 2877 from the House Committee on Health Care to the House Committee on Rules.

The bill requires the Department of Administrative Services to contract with a private entity to evaluate the progress of coordinated care organizations (CCOs) in achieving the goals set by the Legislative Assembly. The Oregon Health Authority is directed to assist the private entity in its evaluation by furnishing information and advice necessary to conduct the evaluation.

The bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Department of Administrative Services and the Oregon Health Authority. The amount of this impact is still being determined.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Rules.
