Measure Description:

Establishes process for county to evaluate whether proposed mining use causes significant change or significant increase in cost when federal or state agency has not issued permit authorizing proposed mining use.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Geology and Mineral Industries (DOGAMI), Department of Land Conservation and Development

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Rural Communities, Land Use, and Water to the House Committee on Rules. The bill establishes process of a county to evaluate mining cases. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined.
