Measure Description:

Requires State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries to develop comprehensive landslide hazard mitigation program.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Department of Forestry, Department of Geology and Mineral Industries (DOGAMI)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Rural Communities, Land Use, and Water to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill requires DOGAMI to develop a comprehensive landslide mitigation program and will have a substantial fiscal impact to the agency. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined.
