# WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Authorizes county to exempt homestead of surviving spouse of fire service professional or police officer killed in line of duty from property taxes imposed by county on first \$250,000 of assessed value of homesteads. Establishes process for requesting exemption. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

### **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Types of property taxes included
- Homesteads included in the possible exemption

# **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:**

Limits exemption to first \$250,000 of assessed value of homestead. Establishes process for requesting exemption.

### **BACKGROUND:**

A property tax is a levy on the assessed value of property. In Oregon, county governments may levy property taxes as a mechanism for funding county programs.

Senate Bill 865-A authorizes counties to exempt from county property taxes the first \$250,000 of assessed value of the homesteads of a surviving spouse of a fallen public safety officer.
