Measure Description:

requires the Environmental Quality Commission to prepare revisions to Oregon’s State Implementation Plan or SIP and submit the plan to the United States Environmental Protection Agency for their review and approval.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Environment and Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill requires the Environmental Quality Commission to prepare revisions to Oregon’s State Implementation Plan or SIP and submit the plan to the United States Environmental Protection Agency for their review and approval.
