WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Authorizes pre-employment polygraph examinations for applicants to law enforcement positions. Prohibits post-employment polygraph examinations. Exempts from public records disclosure pre-employment polygraph examinations and the materials associated with those examinations.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Tools available to law enforcement agencies to better screen applicants
- Examples of recent events in which law enforcement candidates could have been better screened

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

Replaces measure.

BACKGROUND:

State law prohibits polygraph examinations as a condition of employment. Certain law enforcement agencies would like the option of polygraph examinations as a tool to screen law enforcement candidates.
