Measure Description:

Authorizes peace officer to apply for and circuit court to enter ex parte emergency protective order when court finds probable cause that person was victim of domestic disturbance or abuse and protective order is necessary to prevent abuse.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Judicial Department, Oregon State Police (OSP), Department of Justice, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Public Defense Services Commission

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
