WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Specifies that interagency agreement between Oregon Health Authority and Oregon Health and Science University for psychiatric contracts for patients of the Oregon State Hospital may not provide treatment for patients of the hospital in the excess of 25 percent of the total number of physicians providing treatment. Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

BACKGROUND:

The Oregon State Hospital (OSH) is the state's primary state-run psychiatric facility for adults. The mission of OSH is to provide therapeutic, evidence-based, patient-centered treatment focusing on recovery and community reintegration in a safe environment. OSH delivers inpatient psychiatric and medical care to patients through Forensic Psychiatric Services for patients who are judged guilty except for insanity and Psychiatric Recovery Services for civilly committed patients.
