WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Increases tax on motor fuels. Dedicates amount of increase for funding of new projects to improve highways and for retraining of displaced fuel dispensary employees. Allows retail customer to dispense gasoline or other flammable liquids if owner, operator or employee of dispensing facility is in immediate vicinity. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.
