Measure Description:

Allows regulated social worker employed by Department of Human Services to report suspected animal abuse or neglect involving animal or person social worker comes into contact with while acting as employee of department.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Department of Human Services (DHS), Board of Licensed Social Workers, Department of Justice

Analysis:
