**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Designates portion of U.S. Highway 395, known as the Pendleton-John Day Highway, as the Don Kendall Memorial Highway.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Career of Mr. Kendall

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

Don Kendall was born in Nyssa, Oregon, and moved to Ukiah as a young boy. He graduated from Ukiah High School in 1979. Mr. Kendall worked for the Oregon Department of Transportation for thirty years as a transportation maintenance specialist. He was a dedicated employee and was proud of the work performed by the Ukiah maintenance crew. Mr. Kendall was killed in a tragic construction incident on July 22, 2014.

Senate Bill 628 designates the portion of U.S. Highway 395 beginning where the highway intersects with State Highway 74, known as the Heppner Highway, to Ukiah, as the Don Kendall Memorial Highway.
