Establishes the Strategic Public Policy Review Act.

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting House Bill 3314 from the House Committee on Rules to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The bill establishes the Strategic Public Policy Review Act creating a continuing existence Joint Committee on Strategic Public Policy Review charged with reviewing policies public policy initiatives with a more long-term approach.

The bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Legislative Assembly, the Legislative Administration Committee, Legislative Counsel, the Legislative Fiscal Office, the Legislative Revenue Office, and the Secretary of State. The amount of this impact is still being determined.
