#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Oregon Innovation Council (Oregon InC) is a public-private partnership that funds individual initiatives with the potential to build or coalesce industry clusters around new or emerging technology in specific areas where Oregon holds unique advantages. In recent biennia, those clusters have included nanotechnology, clean tech and green building, bioscience, wave energy, electric vehicles, unmanned aerial systems and digital storytelling.
