**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Requires licensed investigator to include name and license number in its advertisements.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Scrivener's oversight when transitioning licensure to Department of Public Safety Standards and Training
- Benefits of information in searchable database

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

Investigators are licensed by the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST). The Department may refuse to grant or renew a license, may suspend or revoke a license or may reprimand a licensee if the investigator does not follow the requirements of conduct that are stated in statute. House Bill 3487 adds a requirement to the code of conduct specifying that all advertisements for the investigator's services include the investigator's name and license number.
