**Measure Description:**

Provides that person who records another person's intimate areas commits crime of invasion of personal privacy.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Cities, Counties, Department of Justice, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, Oregon Youth Authority (OYA), Public Defense Services Commission, Department of Corrections

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
