Measure Description:

Adds civil code enforcement officers to public officials who may request exemption from required disclosure under public records law of specified personal information.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), Cities, Counties, Special Districts, Columbia River Gorge Commission (CRGC), Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS), Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Department of Land Conservation and Development, Department of State Lands, Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA), Water Resources Department

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
