## WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Exempts Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs (ODVA) from foreclosure mediation process required of traditional lenders on home loans ODVA administers.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Veteran home foreclosures
- ODVA's expenses for meditation and mediation fee structure

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

## **BACKGROUND:**

In Oregon, lenders are obligated to participate in mediation with borrowers to avoid foreclosure. The Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs (ODVA) is deemed a lender, because it administers a home loan program for eligible veterans; however, the ODVA home loan program already requires the agency to make every effort to keep veterans in their homes.

Senate Bill 252-A exempts ODVA from foreclosure mediation requirements applicable to traditional lenders, in reliance on the agency's existing mandate to avoid foreclosure.
