Limits liability of land owners for damages resulting from use of land for aviation activities. Provides exceptions. Defines relevant terms. Applies to personal injuries, death and property damage occurring on or after the effective date.

BACKGROUND:

Current Oregon law does not exempt land owners for personal injury, death or property damage arising from the use of land for aviation activities.

House Bill 2038-A limits the liability of land owners for personal injury, death or property damage arising from the use of land for aviation activities except under specified circumstances.
