Measure Description:

Repeals statutory requirements related to specific strategic education investments.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education, Oregon Educational Investment Board

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Rules to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill modifies purposes for which moneys may be distributed for the Oregon Early Reading Program, the Guidance and Support for Post-Secondary Aspirations Program, and the Connecting to the World of Work Program. The amount of funding for the programs included in this bill will be determined during the deliberations on the budgets for Oregon Department of Education and other education agencies. There may be changes made to the bill as the result of these deliberations.
