**Measure Description:**

Repeals unfunded higher education loan, scholarship and grant programs.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Higher Education Coordinating Commission

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have  
**MINIMAL EXPENDITURE IMPACT**  
on state or local government.

While this individual measure has a “Minimal” fiscal impact, an agency may incur a net fiscal impact greater than minimal depending on the cumulative impact of all measures enacted into law that affect the agency.

This fiscal impact assumes that the scholarships contained in the bill, which are awarded by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, do not receive additional funding.
