Measure Description:

Permits any person convicted of felony with relevant DNA evidence to file motion for DNA testing.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Corrections, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon State Police (OSP), Public Defense Services Commission, Department of Justice

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
