**Measure Description:**

Restructures the fee for adoptions and adoption certificates. Specifies that when an adoption is consented by the Department of Human Services, a fee is not to be imposed or collected when a birth parent makes a motion to inspect the adoption records after the adoptee has turned 18.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Human Services (DHS), Department of Justice (DOJ), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD)

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
