WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Makes pre-disaster measures taken to improve resilience inadmissible as evidence of negligence. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

• Provisions of measure and legislative intent

• Recommendations of Oregon Resiliency Task Force

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Recommended inspections that could lead to the discovery and repair of potential infrastructure hazards are often avoided due to concern about possible litigation.

Senate Bill 775-A makes explicit that measures undertaken before a disaster to prepare for that disaster cannot be used as evidence of negligence.
