Measure Description:

Increases Justice Court fees. Authorizes court to order a deposition to perpetuate the testimony of a person subject to a material witness order in a criminal case. Allows any party in justice or municipal court to arrange for recording of the proceedings.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Judicial Department, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Public Defense Services Commission

Analysis:
