Revenue Summary

House Bill 2984 is funded with a one-time General Fund appropriation. Additionally, the bill specifies that the Oregon Department of Forestry and Clackamas County shall enter into a memorandum of understanding for the county to reimburse the department for the actual costs of providing services required under the bill. These reimbursements by the county will be deposited in the State Forestry Department Account established under ORS 526.060.

Summary of Natural Resources Subcommittee Action

House Bill 2984 requires Clackamas County to establish the Clackamas Forestry Product Cooperative Project as a pilot program for forestry products grown on non-forest land. The bill allows for cities within the county to participate in the project and creates a regulatory system intended to grant immunity, from federal and state antitrust laws, to parties of the project. The intent of the bill is to displace competition through a regulatory system for the commercial production and marketing of forestry products on non-forest land under this program.

House Bill 2984 requires the State Forester to actively supervise and establish procedures and guidelines for the negotiations between the parties and to review the prices set by those negotiations. Additionally, the State Forester is required to set prices for forestry products bought and sold as part of the project and may take action to resolve disputes between parties that involve or arise out of the Clackamas Forestry Product Cooperative Project. House Bill 2984 requires the Oregon Department of Forestry and Clackamas County to enter into a memorandum of understanding for the county to reimburse the department for the actual costs of providing services for the benefit of the project.

The Subcommittee established a one-time \$400,000 General Fund appropriation to the Oregon Department of Forestry for the purpose of issuing one or more grants to Clackamas County for studying matters regarding, and making preparations for, the Clackamas Forestry Product Cooperative Project.
