Revenue Summary

Full-time Equivalent (FTE) positions

House Bill 2730 increases Other Funds expenditure limitation for the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) to implement the provisions of the bill. The revenue for this limitation will come from the Transportation Operating Fund, also known as the "lawn-mower" fund because the Constitution prohibits the use of Highway Funds for this purpose. ODOT anticipates the Portland Trail Blazers and the Breast Cancer Awareness organization will pay the startup costs for their respective plates in 2015-17 and any additional revenue generated from these programs is unknown at this time.

Summary of Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee Action

House Bill 2730 eliminates the current limit on the number of special registration license plates and requires ODOT to create a program for new special registration plates, approved administratively for production and distribution. The bill also creates two new special vehicle registration (license) plates: a Portland Trail Blazers plate and a Breast Cancer Awareness plate. The revenue from the Trail Blazers plate will be dedicated to the Trail Blazers Foundation and the revenue from the Breast Cancer Awareness plate will be dedicated to the Oregon Health Authority for the Oregon Breast and Cervical Cancer Program.

Driver and Motor Vehicle Services

The Subcommittee approved an Other Funds expenditure limitation increase of \$248,095 for the implementation of the new specialty license plate program and for the manufacturing costs of the two new specialty license plates created by the bill.
