**Measure Description:**

Implements the statutory changes necessary to support the 2015-17 legislatively adopted budget and to clarify the application of statutes.

**Revenue Impact (in \$Millions):**

**Impact Explanation:** SB 501A shifts revenue previously scheduled to accrue to Other Fund accounts to the General Fund for general governmental purposes in the 2015-17 biennium. The net impact on the 2015-17 General Fund budget is +\$154.1 million with a corresponding reduction in Other Fund revenue for the biennium. These are one time actions taken to complete 2015-17 legislatively adopted budget.
