HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2024

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "creating new provisions; amending ORS 414.710;".
2	Delete lines 5 through 28 and delete <u>page 2</u> and insert:
3	" <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section:
4	"(a) 'Dental home' means a dental care team or clinic that provides the following core
5	services:
6	"(A) Comprehensive dental care;
7	"(B) Basic preventive dental services;
8	"(C) Referral to dental specialists; and
9	"(D) Family centered dental care.
10	"(b) 'Health worker' includes:
11	"(A) A community health worker;
12	"(B) A personal health navigator;
13	"(C) A peer wellness specialist;
14	"(D) A peer support specialist;
15	"(E) A community dental health coordinator; and
16	"(F) A doula.
17	"(2) The Oregon Health Authority, in consultation with coordinated care organizations
18	and dental care organizations in this state, shall adopt rules and procedures for the training
19	and certification of health workers to provide basic preventive dental services to underserved
20	children.
21	"(3) The rules adopted under subsection (2) of this section must prescribe the training
22	required for certification, including instruction on:
23	"(a) The performance of dental risk assessments;
24	"(b) The provision of basic preventive dental services; and
25	"(c) The referral of patients to dental care providers.
26	"(4) The authority shall adopt rules requiring that a certified health worker:
27	"(a) Refer patients to dental homes as determined necessary by the health worker; and
28	"(b) Recommend to patients, or to the parent or legal guardian of a patient, that the
29	patient receive at least one dental risk assessment each year.
30	"(5) The authority shall reimburse the cost of basic preventive dental services provided
31	to medical assistance recipients by a certified health worker, if the services are within the
32	scope of the health worker's certification under this section.
33	"SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2015 Act becomes operative on July 1, 2016.
34	"(2) The Oregon Health Authority may take any action before the operative date specified
35	in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the authority to exercise, on or

1 after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions

2 and powers conferred on the authority by section 1 of this 2015 Act.

3 "<u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 1 of this 2015 Act applies to services provided on or after the op 4 erative date specified in section 2 of this 2015 Act.

5 "<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 6 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 7 on its passage.".

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
