SUMMARY

Authorizes Bureau of Labor and Industries to provide support for outreach and training for employers.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Bureau of Labor and Industries for purposes of Act.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to services provided by Bureau of Labor and Industries to employers. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. The Bureau of Labor and Industries may provide staff support and other resources to assist nonprofit organizations described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Re-5 venue Code that are exempt from income tax under section 501(a) of the Internal Revenue 6 7 Code in conducting outreach efforts and training for employers in this state. 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated to the Bureau of Labor and Industries, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1 for the purposes 9 10 of section 1 of this 2015 Act. 11
