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AN ACT

Relating to lobbyist reporting requirements; creating new provisions; amending section 3, chapter 701, Oregon Laws 2013; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 3, chapter 701, Oregon Laws 2013, is amended to read:

Sec. 3. The amendments to ORS 171.745 by section 2 [of this 2013 Act], chapter 701, Oregon Laws 2013, become operative on June 30, [2015] 2017.

SECTION 2. If this 2015 Act does not become effective until after June 30, 2015, the amendments to section 3, chapter 701, Oregon Laws 2013, by section 1 of this 2015 Act revive section 1, chapter 701, Oregon Laws 2013. If this 2015 Act does not become effective until after June 30, 2015, this 2015 Act shall be operative retroactively to that date, and the operation and effect of section 1, chapter 701, Oregon Laws 2013, shall continue unaffected from June 30, 2015, to the effective date of this 2015 Act and thereafter. Any otherwise lawful action taken or otherwise lawful obligation incurred under the authority of section 1, chapter 701, Oregon Laws 2013, after June 30, 2015, and before the effective date of this 2015 Act, is ratified and approved.

SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.
