

House Bill 2093

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Revenue)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires joint legislative interim committee on revenue to study costs and benefits of Oregon's tax expenditures and make recommendations to Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to tax expenditures; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The joint legislative interim committee on revenue, or other appropriate**
5 **legislative interim committee dealing with issues of revenue and taxation, shall conduct a**
6 **study of the costs and benefits of Oregon's tax expenditures.**

7 **(2) Based on the outcome of the study, the interim committee shall make recommen-**
8 **dations to the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2015**
10 **regular session of the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
