SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires joint legislative interim committee on revenue to study costs and benefits of Oregon's tax expenditures and make recommendations to Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to tax expenditures; and prescribing an effective date.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The joint legislative interim committee on revenue, or other appropriate

5 legislative interim committee dealing with issues of revenue and taxation, shall conduct a

6 study of the costs and benefits of Oregon's tax expenditures.

7 (2) Based on the outcome of the study, the interim committee shall make recommen-8 dations to the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly.

9 SECTION 2. This 2015 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2015

10 regular session of the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
