## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to elections; and declaring an emergency.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

12 RESULT OF "YES" VOTE: "Yes" vote allows bills that repeal or suspend operation of a tax 13 expenditure to pass with a simple majority of both houses.

RESULT OF "NO" VOTE: "No" vote retains the current constitutional requirement that bills
that repeal or suspend operation of a tax expenditure receive a three-fifths majority vote in
both houses.

SUMMARY: This measure allows bills that repeal or suspend operation of a tax expenditure
to pass with a simple majority of both houses.

23 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The ballot title in section 1 of this 2015 Act shall be printed in the voters' 24 pamphlet and on the ballot.

25 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 26 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 27 on its passage.
