

House Bill 2125

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Revenue)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Extends sunset for tax credit for rural medical care.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to a tax credit for rural medical care; amending section 25, chapter 913, Oregon Laws 2009.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** Section 25, chapter 913, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by section 10, chapter 750,
5 Oregon Laws 2013, is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 25.** (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, a credit may not be claimed
7 under ORS 315.613 for tax years beginning on or after January 1, [2016] **2022**.

8 (2) A taxpayer who meets the eligibility requirements in ORS 315.613 for the tax year beginning
9 on or after January 1, [2013] **2021**, and before January 1, [2014] **2022**, shall be allowed the credit
10 under ORS 315.613 for any tax year:

11 (a) That begins on or before January 1, [2023] **2031**; and

12 (b) For which the taxpayer meets the eligibility requirements of ORS 315.613.
