

House Bill 2145

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Revenue)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Specifies ballot title for House Joint Resolution 1 (2015).
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to elections; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Pursuant to ORS 250.075 and notwithstanding ORS 250.035, the ballot title**
5 **for House Joint Resolution 1 (2015), if House Joint Resolution 1 (2015) is referred to the**
6 **people by the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly in regular session, shall be:**

9 **AMENDS CONSTITUTION: ALLOWS BILLS FOR RAISING REVENUE TO PASS WITH**
10 **SIMPLE MAJORITY OF BOTH HOUSES.**

12 **RESULT OF "YES" VOTE: "Yes" vote allows bills for raising revenue to pass with a simple**
13 **majority of both houses.**

15 **RESULT OF "NO" VOTE: "No" vote retains current constitutional requirement that bills for**
16 **raising revenue receive a three-fifths majority vote in both houses.**

18 **SUMMARY: This measure allows bills for raising revenue to pass with a simple majority of**
19 **both houses.**

22 **SECTION 2. The ballot title in section 1 of this 2015 Act shall be printed in the voters'**
23 **pamphlet and on the ballot.**

24 **SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
25 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
26 **on its passage.**
