House Bill 2145

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Specifies ballot title for House Joint Resolution 1 (2015). Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to elections; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Pursuant to ORS 250.075 and notwithstanding ORS 250.035, the ballot title
5	for House Joint Resolution 1 (2015), if House Joint Resolution 1 (2015) is referred to the
6	people by the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly in regular session, shall be:

8	
9	AMENDS CONSTITUTION: ALLOWS BILLS FOR RAISING REVENUE TO PASS WITH
10	SIMPLE MAJORITY OF BOTH HOUSES.
11	
12	RESULT OF "YES" VOTE: "Yes" vote allows bills for raising revenue to pass with a simple
13	majority of both houses.
14	
15	RESULT OF "NO" VOTE: "No" vote retains current constitutional requirement that bills for
16	raising revenue receive a three-fifths majority vote in both houses.
17	
18	SUMMARY: This measure allows bills for raising revenue to pass with a simple majority of
19	both houses.

22	SECTION 2. The ballot title in section 1 of this 2015 Act shall be printed in the voters
23	pamphlet and on the ballot.
24	SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
25	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
26	on its passage.
