

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2195

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 12 through 14 and insert:

2 “(C) Third, to refund the county general fund for all the costs and expenses incurred by the  
3 county in the maintenance and supervision of the properties and in any suits or proceedings by the  
4 county to quiet title to or to defend the county’s title to property sold, including but not limited to  
5 suits or land use proceedings to ascertain and determine the actual boundaries of the properties.”.

6 After line 23, insert:

7 “(c) In a county with a population of 650,000 or more, after the refunds authorized under para-  
8 graph (a) of this subsection are made, the county treasurer may credit the balance of the proceeds  
9 arising under ORS 275.090 to 275.290 from the sale of real property acquired by the county through  
10 foreclosure of delinquent tax liens or by exchange for land originally acquired by foreclosure of  
11 delinquent tax liens, as provided in paragraph (d) of this subsection.”.

12 In line 24, delete “(c)” and insert “(d)”.

13 Delete line 30 and insert:

14 “(i) Funds for housing placement and retention support services for youth and families with  
15 children;

16 “(ii) Flexible rental assistance to place youth and families with children into housing; or

17 “(iii) Funds to develop new low income housing that is affordable to youth and families with  
18 children with 30 percent or lower median family income.”.

19 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2.

20 On page 3, after line 6, insert:

21 “(7) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, a county with a population of 650,000 or  
22 more may convey real property acquired by foreclosure of delinquent tax liens or by exchange for  
23 land originally acquired by foreclosure of delinquent tax liens as provided in ORS 271.330 or  
24 311.796.”.

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
