

# House Bill 2196

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Human Services and Housing)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Human Services to submit report related to child victims of commercial sexual exploitation to interim legislative committees no later than July 1, 2016.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to child victims of commercial sexual exploitation; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) No later than July 1, 2016, the Department of Human Services shall**  
5 **submit a report to the interim legislative committees that have authority over the subject**  
6 **area of child welfare regarding the incidence of commercial sexual exploitation of children**  
7 **and the availability of services for child victims of commercial sexual exploitation. The report**  
8 **must include:**

9 (a) **A summary of available data regarding known occurrences of child commercial sexual**  
10 **exploitation and outcomes, and the availability of protective, shelter and medical services for**  
11 **child victims of commercial sexual exploitation.**

12 (b) **Recommendations for legislative or other changes that may result in prevention and**  
13 **interventions for child victims of commercial sexual exploitation.**

14 (2) **When preparing the report, the department shall consult with the Oregon Health**  
15 **Authority.**

16 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
17 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**  
18 **on its passage.**
