House Bill 2234

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Oregon Health Authority and insurers offering policies or certificates of health insurance that reimburse costs of physician services to create billing codes or alternative mechanism to enable community assessment center to bill for child abuse medical assessment and related services.

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A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to child abuse medical assessments; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 750.055 3 and 750.333.

6 (a) "Child abuse medical assessment" has the meaning given that term in ORS 418.782.

8 (2) The Oregon Health Authority shall create billing codes for child abuse medical as-

9 sessments, and for services directly related to the medical assessments, that are performed

10 by community assessment centers to enable the centers to bill the medical assistance pro-

11 gram for assessments of children who are recipients of medical assistance and for perform-

12ing services directly related to the assessment.
