

House Bill 2263

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Transportation and Economic Development)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Transportation to take action necessary to ensure that department policies and activities are implemented in manner that supports enforcement of offense of acting as vehicle dealer without certificate.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to offense of acting as a vehicle dealer without a certificate.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle Code.

SECTION 2. In furtherance of imposing penalties on persons who commit the offense of acting as a vehicle dealer without a certificate under ORS 822.005, the Department of Transportation shall take action necessary to ensure that department policies and activities are implemented in a manner that supports enforcement of ORS 822.005.
