

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2282

By COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “transportation” insert “; creating new provisions; and
2 amending ORS 822.043”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 11 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle
5 Code.**

6 **“SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, ‘electronic signature’ has the meaning given
7 that term in ORS 84.004.**

8 **“(2) The Department of Transportation may receive electronically transmitted documents
9 necessary to:**

10 **“(a) Issue or transfer a certificate of title for a vehicle;**

11 **“(b) Register a vehicle or transfer registration of a vehicle;**

12 **“(c) Issue a registration plate; or**

13 **“(d) Comply with odometer disclosure requirements.**

14 **“(3) Except as required in ORS 803.094 and 803.205 for affidavits, an acknowledgement
15 before a notary public is not required when a document or signature is transmitted elec-
16 tronically under this section. When an affidavit is required under ORS 803.094 or 803.205, the
17 department may accept a scanned copy of the person’s signature and a scanned copy of the
18 notary public’s acknowledgment of the signature, which accurately reproduces the original
19 signatures and contents of the document.**

20 **“(4) The department may adopt rules relating to the electronic transmission of docu-
21 ments and the use of electronic signatures on documents described in subsection (2) of this
22 section.**

23 **“SECTION 3. ORS 822.043 is amended to read:**

24 **“822.043. (1) As used in this section:**

25 **“(a) ‘Integrator’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 802.600.**

26 **“(b) ‘Vehicle dealer’ means a person issued a vehicle dealer certificate under ORS 822.020.**

27 **“(2) A vehicle dealer may elect to prepare, submit, or prepare and submit documents necessary
28 to:**

29 **“(a) Issue or transfer a certificate of title for a vehicle;**

30 **“(b) Register a vehicle or transfer registration of a vehicle; or**

31 **“(c) Issue a registration plate.**

32 **“(3) A vehicle dealer who prepares any documents described in subsection (2) of this section:**

33 **“(a) May charge a purchaser of a vehicle a fee for the preparation of those documents.**

34 **“(b) May not charge a purchaser of a vehicle a fee for the submission of any document or the
35 issuance of a registration plate.**

1 “(c) **May charge a purchaser of a vehicle a fee for performing any of the following ser-**
2 **vices in connection with preparing the documents described in subsection (2) of this section:**

3 “(A) **Verifying and clearing titles;**

4 “(B) **Perfecting, releasing or satisfying liens or other security interests;**

5 “(C) **Complying with federal security requirements; and**

6 “(D) **Any other services rendered by a vehicle dealer for the purpose of complying with**
7 **state and federal laws related to the sale of a vehicle.**

8 “(4) **The fee charged by a vehicle dealer under this section may not exceed:**

9 “(a) **\$150, if the vehicle dealer uses an integrator; or**

10 “(b) **\$115, if the vehicle dealer does not use an integrator.**

11 “[(4) *The Department of Transportation may adopt rules to:*]

12 “[(a) *Limit the amount of a fee charged under subsection (3) of this section. The limit established*
13 *by rule may not be less than:*]

14 “[(A) *\$75, if the vehicle dealer uses an integrator; or*]

15 “[(B) *\$50, if the vehicle dealer does not use an integrator.*]

16 “[(b) *Determine when a vehicle dealer is required to inform the purchaser of the vehicle of the op-*
17 *tion of using an integrator and when the purchaser has the option of electing to use an integrator.*]

18 “(5) **If a vehicle dealer charges a fee under subsection (4)(a) of this section, of the amount**
19 **collected \$25 shall be paid to the integrator.**

20 “[(5)] (6) **Unless otherwise provided by rule, if a vehicle dealer uses an integrator and charges**
21 **a fee greater than that charged for not using an integrator, the dealer must inform the purchaser**
22 **of the vehicle of the option of using an integrator to prepare the documents. The purchaser may**
23 **then elect whether or not to have the vehicle dealer use an integrator to prepare the documents.”.**
