## House Bill 2304

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires hospitals to expend 10 percent of community benefit funds on public health infrastructure.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to community benefits provided by hospitals.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 442.

5 SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Health Authority may not renew a license for a hospital

6 under ORS 441.025 if the community benefit report submitted by the hospital under ORS

7 442.205 fails to demonstrate that at least 10 percent of community benefit funds expended

8 by the hospital in the previous 12 months were expended on public health infrastructure.

9 (2) The authority shall prescribe by rule the expenditures that qualify as expenditures for
10 public health infrastructure.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> Section 2 of this 2015 Act applies to license renewal applications submitted
on or after January 1, 2017.
