

House Bill 2394

Sponsored by Representatives OLSON, WHITSETT; Representatives BUCKLEY, ESQUIVEL, GILLIAM, GOMBERG, KRIEGER, Senators DEMBROW, KRUSE, ROBLAN (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Director of Oregon State Lottery to provide information about lottery prize recipient to Department of Human Services within seven days after paying lottery prize of \$1,000 or more.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to public benefits of lottery prize winners; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 461.**

5 **SECTION 2. For the purpose of complying with section 4009 of the Agricultural Act of**
6 **2014, P.L. 113-79, within seven days after paying a prize of \$1,000 or more, the Director of the**
7 **Oregon State Lottery shall notify the Department of Human Services of the name of the**
8 **prize recipient, the Social Security number of the recipient, any other available identifying**
9 **information about the recipient and the amount of the prize paid to the recipient.**

10 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2015 Act applies to lottery prizes paid on or after the ef-**
11 **fective date of this 2015 Act.**

12 **SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
13 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
14 **on its passage.**
