House Bill 2430

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Governor John A. Kitzhaber, M.D., for Oregon State Police)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Authorizes Department of State Police and State Fire Marshal to accept and distribute gifts, grants, donations and funds from any source, including services and property, to carry out duties of department or marshal.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to property in the hands of the Department of State Police; amending ORS 181.175 and 476.033; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 181.175 is amended to read:

- 181.175. (1) There is established in the General Fund of the State Treasury an account to be known as the State Police Account. All moneys received by the Department of State Police shall be paid to the credit of the State Police Account, and such moneys are continuously appropriated to the department for the payment of expenses of the department [of State Police].
- (2) There is established a subaccount in the State Police Account consisting of all moneys, revenue and income described in ORS 463.220. All moneys in the subaccount are **continuously** appropriated [continuously] to the Department of State Police to carry out the provisions of ORS chapter 463.
- (3) The Department of State Police may accept and distribute gifts, grants, donations and funds from any source, including services and property, to carry out the duties of the department.

SECTION 2. ORS 476.033 is amended to read:

- 476.033. The State Fire Marshal may:
- (1) Contract or otherwise cooperate with any person or public agency for the procurement of necessary services or property;
- (2) Accept [gifts or grants of services or property] and distribute gifts, grants, donations and funds from any source, including services and property, to carry out the duties of the State Fire Marshal; and
 - (3) Perform such other duties as required by law.
- SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.

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
