

# House Bill 2475

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor John A. Kitzhaber, M.D., for Oregon State Veterinary Medical Examining Board)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes Oregon State Veterinary Medical Examining Board to impose \$100 fine on individual regulated by board who commits administrative or clerical violation that does not create risk of harm to public.

2 Relating to veterinary medicine.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 686.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) Subject to the provisions of ORS chapter 183 and subsection (2) of this**  
6 **section, the Oregon State Veterinary Medical Examining Board may impose a fine on any**  
7 **permit or license holder under this chapter for an administrative or clerical violation of this**  
8 **chapter or a rule adopted pursuant to this chapter if the violation does not create a risk of**  
9 **harm to the public, as established by the board by rule.**

10 **(2) A fine imposed under this section may not exceed \$100.**
