SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Authorizes Oregon State Veterinary Medical Examining Board to impose \$100 fine on individual regulated by board who commits administrative or clerical violation that does not create risk of harm to public.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to veterinary medicine. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 686. 4 5 SECTION 2. (1) Subject to the provisions of ORS chapter 183 and subsection (2) of this 6 section, the Oregon State Veterinary Medical Examining Board may impose a fine on any 7 permit or license holder under this chapter for an administrative or clerical violation of this 8 chapter or a rule adopted pursuant to this chapter if the violation does not create a risk of 9 harm to the public, as established by the board by rule. 10 (2) A fine imposed under this section may not exceed \$100.
