1 Delete lines 6 through 12 of the printed bill and insert:

² "<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) During a regular or special session of the Legislative Assembly, at least ³ two members of a Senate or House committee related to revenue, including at least one ⁴ member from each major political party, may request that the Legislative Revenue Officer ⁵ prepare an economic impact statement for any measure or proposed amendments to any ⁶ measure.

7 "(2) The request for preparation of an economic impact statement must identify the 8 deadline for completion of the statement.

9 "(3) Upon receiving a request for preparation of an economic impact statement, the 10 Legislative Revenue Officer shall respond to the members with a statement describing:

"(a) Whether preparation of an economic impact statement is feasible with the available
resources of the Legislative Revenue Office; and

"(b) If preparation of the statement is feasible, the amount of time necessary to complete
the statement.

"(4) If preparation of the economic impact statement is feasible within the time available,
the Legislative Revenue Officer shall prepare the statement.

17 "(5) An economic impact statement prepared under this section must describe, at a 18 minimum, the direct and indirect effects the measure would, if enacted, have on the Oregon 19 economy or indicate that the measure would have no effect.".
