House Bill 2541

Sponsored by Representatives DOHERTY, KENNEMER, GREENLICK; Representative LIVELY (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires physician, physician assistant or individual licensed to practice nursing, in specified numbers, to be present at blood drives. Requires assessments of blood donor suitability to be performed by physician, physician assistant or individual licensed to practice nursing.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to blood drives.

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3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "blood drive" means an event where individuals 5 voluntarily allow their blood to be drawn for the purpose of creating a supply of blood for 6 medical purposes, such as providing blood transfusions or making biopharmaceutical 7 medications by fractionation.

8 (2) A person conducting a blood drive:

9 (a) May not collect blood during the blood drive unless at least one individual who is 10 qualified as specified in subsection (3) of this section is present at the blood drive.

(b) May not collect 50 units of blood or more during the blood drive unless at least two
 individuals who are qualified as specified in subsection (3) of this section are present at the
 blood drive.

(c) Must require all assessments of blood donor suitability to be performed by an indi vidual who is qualified as specified in subsection (3) of this section.

(3) A person is qualified for purposes of this section if the person is a physician or phy sician assistant licensed under ORS chapter 677 or an individual licensed to practice nursing
 under ORS 678.010 to 678.410.

(4) Subject to the provisions of ORS chapter 183, the Oregon Health Authority may impose a civil penalty of up to \$1,000 for each violation of this section. All moneys collected
pursuant to this subsection shall be deposited in the Oregon Health Authority Fund established under ORS 413.101 and are continuously appropriated to the authority for the purpose
of carrying out the duties, functions and powers of the authority under this section.

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
