

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2568

1 On page 3 of the printed bill, delete lines 21 through 45.

2 On page 4, delete lines 1 through 28 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 11. The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall monthly determine the**
4 **amount that is equal to:**

5 **“(1) One cent for each bottle of distilled liquor having a volume of not less than 50 but**
6 **less than 350 milliliters sold by the commission in the last-reported sales month;**

7 **“(2) Two cents for each bottle of distilled liquor having a volume of not less than 350 but**
8 **less than 750 milliliters sold by the commission in the last-reported sales month;**

9 **“(3) Three cents for each bottle of distilled liquor having a volume of not less than 750**
10 **milliliters but less than 1.5 liters sold by the commission in the last-reported sales month;**
11 **and**

12 **“(4) Four cents for each bottle of distilled liquor having a volume of 1.5 liters or more**
13 **sold by the commission in the last-reported sales month.**

14 **“SECTION 12. The Oregon Spirits Board shall biennially report to the Legislative As-**
15 **sembly as provided under ORS 192.235 to 192.245 and 293.640 no later than September 15 fol-**
16 **lowing the close of the reporting period. The report must include, but need not be limited to,**
17 **a description of the amounts, types and purposes of board expenditures to carry out sections**
18 **1 to 9 of this 2015 Act and an evaluation of the state of the distilled liquor industry in**
19 **Oregon, including, but not limited to, an analysis of the effectiveness of board activities un-**
20 **der sections 1 to 9 of this 2015 Act in enhancing and growing the distilled liquor industry and**
21 **workforce.**

22 **“SECTION 13. ORS 471.810 is amended to read:**

23 **“471.810. (1) At the end of each month, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall certify the**
24 **amount of moneys available for distribution in the Oregon Liquor Control Commission Account [*and,***
25 ***after withholding*]. **The commission shall withhold** such moneys as it may deem necessary to pay
26 its outstanding obligations[, *shall*] **and**, within 35 days of the month for which a distribution is made
27 [*direct the State Treasurer to pay the amounts due, upon warrants drawn by the Oregon Department*
28 *of Administrative Services*], **transfer the remaining available moneys for payment** as follows:**

29 **“(a) Fifty-six percent[,]** or the amount remaining after the distribution under subsection (4) of
30 this section, **minus the amount described in paragraph (e) of this subsection, to be credited to**
31 **the General Fund available for general governmental purposes wherein it shall be considered as**
32 **revenue during the quarter immediately preceding receipt;**

33 **“(b) Twenty percent to the cities of the state in such shares as the population of each city bears**
34 **to the population of the cities of the state, as determined by Portland State University last preceding**
35 **such apportionment, under ORS 190.510 to 190.610;**

1 “(c) Ten percent to counties in such shares as their respective populations bear to the total
2 population of the state, as estimated from time to time by Portland State University; [and]

3 “(d) Fourteen percent to the cities of the state to be distributed as provided in ORS 221.770 and
4 this section[.]; **and**

5 “(e) **The amount determined by the commission under section 11 of this 2015 Act for**
6 **crediting to the Oregon Spirits Board Fund.**

7 “(2) The commission shall [*direct the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to*] transfer
8 50 percent of the revenues from the taxes imposed by ORS 473.030 and 473.035 to the Mental Health
9 Alcoholism and Drug Services Account in the General Fund [*to be paid monthly*] **for monthly pay-**
10 **ment** as provided in ORS 430.380.

11 “(3) If the amount of revenues received from the taxes imposed by ORS 473.030 for the preceding
12 month was reduced as a result of credits claimed under ORS 473.047, the commission shall compute
13 the difference between the amounts [*paid or*] **that would be** transferred as described in subsections
14 (1)(b), (c) and (d) and (2) of this section and the amounts that would have been [*paid or*] transferred
15 under subsections (1)(b), (c) and (d) and (2) of this section if no credits had been claimed. The com-
16 mission shall [*direct the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to pay or transfer amounts*
17 *equal to*] **deduct** the differences computed for subsections (1)(b), (c) and (d) and (2) of this section
18 from the [*General Fund*] **amount that would otherwise be transferred to the General Fund and**
19 **apply that amount to increase the amounts transferred** to the recipients or accounts described
20 in subsections (1)(b), (c) and (d) and (2) of this section.

21 “(4) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, no city or county shall receive for any fiscal
22 year an amount less than the amount distributed to the city or county in accordance with ORS
23 471.350 (1965 Replacement Part), 471.810, 473.190 and 473.210 (1965 Replacement Part) during the
24 1966-1967 fiscal year unless the city or county had a decline in population as shown by its census.
25 If the population declined, the per capita distribution to the city or county shall be not less than
26 the total per capita distribution during the 1966-1967 fiscal year. Any additional funds required to
27 maintain the level of distribution under this subsection shall be paid from [*funds credited*] **moneys**
28 **that would otherwise be transferred to the General Fund** under subsection (1)(a) of this
29 section.”.

30 In line 29, delete “13” and insert “14”.

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
