

House Bill 2601

Sponsored by Representative SMITH WARNER; Representatives FAGAN, KENY-GUYER (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires member of law enforcement agency who receives report of abducted child to notify Oregon State Police Missing Children Clearinghouse within 24 hours of receiving report.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to missing children; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. A member of a law enforcement agency who receives a report of the**
5 **abduction of a child shall notify the Oregon State Police missing children clearinghouse**
6 **within 24 hours of receiving the report.**

7 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act and ORS 181.505 and 181.506 are added to and made**
8 **a part of ORS 181.010 to 181.560.**

9 **SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
